# The cold stays out

Modern petdoors help to save heating costs

Grey and dirty weather, snow storms, and icy winds: on days like these you'd rather stay inside, where it is warm and cozy. Pets; however, enjoy being outside no matter how the weather conditions are. The challenge for house and flat owners is to find a proper solution for an independent entry and exit for cats and dogs - but with the least possible loss of energy during the cold season. To keep heating costs as low as possible, there are common tips to follow such as shock ventilation, turning the heat down, or investing in good building insulation in order to enhance energy efficiency and promote thermal comfort.

## Pet doors that save energy

Many pet owners fear installing an unimpeded entry to the garden for their four legged friends, as it may become a weak spot in their building's insulation. Since conventional pet flaps are made of hard plastic, they don't have any insulating properties and physically represent a hole in the house. This leads to a thermal bridge, which allows thermal energy to escape. The cold air that enters through the joints of the flap needs to be compensated and reheated by the heating system. Of course, this process affects heating costs immediately. In buildings with air heating systems, commonly used in passive houses, the increased heating load cannot be compensated anymore under certain circumstances; i.e. on cold winter days desired room temperatures will be hard to achieve. However, there also are high quality pet doors, for example from petWALK, which even meet the requirements of a low-energy house with their extraordinary insulation values. Uncontrolled air currents or cold feet due to draughts are history. With the help of polyurethane hard integral foam and the use of double seals, petWALK petdoors close airtight and are therefore also suitable for modern buildings with controlled ventilation systems.
